Chairperson's report

It has been a busy year for the Trust and already we are well over half way through. We reported on the plans for the enhancement and redevelopment project for the springs in our March newsletter. We have since established a group to oversee the project comprising Renata Tane, Nicole Butler and Tracey Dalton. We have also appointed a project manager, Paul White Torea Tai Consultants Ltd, to manage the first phase of this project. He has commenced work and we will keep beneficiaries updated as the work progresses.

We want to apologise for the current state of the pools. We have delayed doing extensive repairs in anticipation of the enhancement and redevelopment project getting underway. This has taken longer than we hoped so we have now put into action a 6 month maintenance programme commencing in the next month. We are doing this by taking advantage of the government's community max initiative.

The AGM is coming up soon so we are also getting prepared for that. This year it is being held on 7 November 2009 at Pakanae Marae. We hope that you will attend to hear the progress the trustees have been making over the past year. This newsletter includes the draft agenda for your information.

You will note that there are vacant trustee positions that need to be filled. We encourage those whanau to fill those positions. The Trust has a lot to do and needs all hands on deck. When considering who to appoint, please note that it is important that the person you put forward is committed to fulfil the duties required to progress the Trust's functions. This includes attending all meetings and undertaking work for the Trust on a regular basis.
